## Children's Summer Camp Program 2010



At Austin School of Fashion Design, our Children's Summer Camp Program offers a full range of classes for children and teens (ages 8-16) that want to learn skills relating to fashion design, sewing, and illustration. The classes we offer include:

- **Beginning Sewing**
- **Intermediate Sewing**
- **Fashion Illustration**
- **Advanced Fashion Illustration**
- **Purse & Bag Design**
- **Boots & Slippers**
- **Matching Outfit – Skirt & Jacket**
- **Accessories & More**

Any student can have a fun and educational experience by taking just one or two of our classes. However, we have arranged the schedule to allow students to take full advantage of our program with classes that build upon one another for four consecutive weeks. For example, during their first week, a student could take Beginning Sewing in the morning and Fashion Illustration in the afternoon. The second week, they could take Intermediate Sewing and Advanced Fashion Illustration. The third and fourth week offers a variety of advanced sewing project classes that will further enhance a student's skills. Of course, this is only one example; our schedule can accommodate each student's individual needs and interests. Please see our FAQs for more information about suggested order for classes and prerequisites.

If a student has registered for 2 classes on the same day, they are welcome to stay at the school during the break from 12-1pm and eat a lunch that they have brought. (We do not provide lunch.) There will always be an instructor here to watch over them.

Our goal at the Austin School of Fashion Design is to take these "arts" seriously and teach with the same discipline that we use in our adult classes. We want the students to have fun while learning skills they can take with them and use for a lifetime!

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## Children's Summer Camp Program 2010 Frequently Asked Questions

### **Is everyone welcome to attend?**

Our program is designed for children ages 8-16 who have an interest in fashion design, sewing, and illustration. While the majority of our students are female, we welcome and encourage boys in our classes.

### **Does my child need to bring any supplies to class?**

No, all supplies are provided here at the school.

### **Can I register my child for more than one class on the same day? Can they stay during the break between classes?**

Absolutely! Students are welcome to stay at the school during the break between classes from 12-1pm. During this time, students often eat lunch, get to know their fellow students, and practice the skills they have learned in class. It may also be helpful for them to bring a book or other independent activity. There is always an instructor on hand to watch over them.

### **Do you provide lunch?**

No. If your child will be staying with us between classes, please provide them with a packed lunch. We have a small refrigerator, a microwave, and a water cooler for the student's use.

### **My child would like to take several classes. Does she have to take them in a particular order?**

Yes and no. Please see the next page for our Recommended Order of Classes. There are no prerequisites for Beginning Sewing or Fashion Illustration. However, Intermediate Sewing requires a student to have beginning sewing skills. Our Advanced Sewing classes cannot be taken unless a student has already attended Beginning and Intermediate Sewing as it is an application of skills learned in those courses. For more information about requirements for advanced classes, please see the Advanced Classes Calendar.

### **What are your school hours?**

Our normal office hours are Mon-Thurs 9:30am-3:30pm. We also have classes 6-8pm. During the summer, we are also open on Fridays 9:30am-3:30pm.

### **May I visit your school before the summer program?**

Yes, we would love to meet you! The best hours to stop by are Mon-Thurs 10:00am-3:30pm. During this time, there will always be someone available to speak with you. If you stop by later in the day, it is possible to pickup printed information or drop off a payment, but instructors will be unable to take time away from class to speak with you at length.

### **Do you offer classes for adults?**

Yes, our adult classes are offered throughout the year. Please visit our website ([www.asfdesigns.com](http://www.asfdesigns.com)) to see our adult schedule.

### **What is the cost for classes in the Children's Summer Camp Program?**

Each class lasts five days (Monday-Friday) for two hours each day and costs \$150.00.

### **How do I register my child? How do I pay?**

You may register for and purchase classes online at our website ([www.asfdesigns.com](http://www.asfdesigns.com)). For payment, we accept Paypal at the time of registration, or you may drop by with a check or mail a check to the address listed at the top of the page. **Our summer classes often fill up fast!** Please register and purchase classes early to avoid disappointment.

**What is your cancellation policy?**

If you need to cancel a course, please do so at least 72 hours before the first class meeting in order to receive full reimbursement of your tuition. Students who fail to notify the school of a course cancellation within the 72-hour period will be charged a fee equal to 20% of the total class fee. If the student has attended any of the classes, no tuition will be reimbursed. Classes take preparation, time and scheduling, so your consideration is greatly appreciated.

**Recommended Order of Classes**

The following will give you a general idea of the most common progression of classes for our summer camp students. Students by no means have to follow the schedule listed, but some courses have prerequisites. Please see the class description on our website or call the school for further information regarding prerequisites.

# Summer Camp 2010 Courses

There are no supplies necessary for any of our classes. All materials are provided.

## **Beginning Sewing**

NO EXPERIENCE NECESSARY. MACHINES PROVIDED.

This sewing class is open for kids/teens ages 8-16. It is for children with no prior machine sewing experience. Students learn about the sewing machine and various things it can do -- how to thread and operate it, how to sew seams and finishes, and, of course, everyone will construct and sew some fun basic items. The class will culminate with sewing a cute apron to wear home. This is where it all begins!

## **Intermediate Sewing (New Projects for 2010!)**

This class is for students who have completed Beginning Sewing, or have comparable experience. Students will be sewing a lightweight robe, nightgown, and reversible bag – perfect for sleepovers! Students will apply the skills and techniques learned in Beginning Sewing, and learn many more - including applying bias tape, hemming, etc. Returning students who took Intermediate Sewing last year might want to take this class again, so they can make these brand new projects!

## **Fashion Illustration**

Fashion Illustration differs from normal body rendering in that the model, or croque, is drawn with an elongated pose. Students will learn to use this croque as a guide in drawing fashion poses and garments, faces, hair, accessories, textures and backgrounds. No prior drawing experience is necessary-if you can draw a box, you can learn fashion drawing! This is one of our most popular classes, so register early!

## **Advanced Fashion Illustration**

After Beginning Fashion Illustration, students will progress further into drawing clothing, fabric representation and poses. Creating a final portfolio will be the goal of this class.

## **Advanced Sewing: Purse & Bag Design**

This class features all new purses for 2010 including a duffel bag with a zipper and a pleated purse from a commercial pattern, making this the perfect class for students interested in understanding how to read a commercial pattern. Students can expect to complete about four different purses or bags in this class.

## **Advanced Sewing: Accessories & More**

Students will build up their existing skill set and learn new techniques in this fun class! Each day, students will sew a new and exciting project. These projects will include a stuffed monster, fabric flowers, a fun embellished headband, and more!

## **Advanced Sewing: Matching Outfit – Skirt & Jacket**

Students will be taking their existing sewing skills up a notch when they learn to sew an age-appropriate matching bolero jacket and skirt. In addition to making a wearable project, students will expand their understanding of how garments are constructed. These projects will teach students many new skills and build confidence in their ability to sew more complicated fashion items!

## **Advanced Sewing: Boots & Slippers**

This class will introduce students to a completely new concept – sewing footwear! Students will construct a stylish pair of lined Ugg-style boots\* and customizable monster slippers! Both of these fun projects require students to work with new materials and master new techniques.

\*These boots have rubberized gripper sole, but are intended for indoor use only.

## **Advanced Sewing From a Pattern**

In this class, we will learn about all aspects of sewing from a commercial pattern, including sizing, cutting and following printed directions. The age-appropriate garment will require students to utilize and build upon their existing skill set.

## **Beginning Patternmaking for Kids**

In this class, students will learn how to turn a project idea into a finished item. Many new skills will be learned along the way, and kids will leave with a basic understanding of a completely new fashion design concept. Students will learn how to make simple patterns, cut their fabric and sew their creation!
